The Sailing Port of Ajaccio's Citadel was named Port Tino Rossi, in tribute to the famous XXth Century Corsican singer Constantino Rossi (aka Tino, 1907-1983), who got famous beyond the Mediterranean following numerous hits, such as « Petit Papa Noël » (1949 Gold Record), which is still the bestselling album today in France. Tino Rossi sold more than 500 million albums over his 50 year career. He rests in the maritime cemetery of his hometown Ajaccio. Rocked by the Mediterranean sea, the Marina and Fishing Port of Ajaccio Tino Rossi welcomes you to the heart of the Imperial City for the most beautiful call ever.

### THE BRANCALEONI WHARF OF HONOUR

As for the the four floats perpendicular to the pier and the main captainship, they are reserved for welcoming sailing boats up to 19 m long.

# Le Musée du Salon Napoléonien

In memory of the imperial family, the Napoleonic museum located at the heart of the City Hall of Ajaccio, houses the Napoleonic lounge and the medal room. Open daily; closed on Saturdays, Sundays, public holidays and during exceptional events and ceremonies.

# Palais Fesch - Musée des Beaux-Arts

The Palace was built by Cardinal Fesch, Napoleon 1st's uncle, and one of the greatest art collector of his time. At the time of his death in 1839, he owned over 19,000 paintings, most of them Italian ones. Today, the museum offers a large collection of Italian paintings: the Italian Primitives, Roman Baroque painting, Napoleonic Baroque painting; landscapes, popular scenes and still life from the Flemish school, a Napoleonic collection and a collection of Corsican paintings. Opened daily. Closed on Tuesdays and public holidays.

# Statue de Napoléon et ses frères

On Place Charles de Gaulle (aka Place du Diamant), which separates the old town from Ajaccio's new districts, there is a monument dedicated to Napoleon and his four brothers; it was erected according to Violet Le Duc's blueprints in 1865. It was nicknamed « the inkwell », due to its shape.

#### **U** Casone

In that green open air theatre which houses all kinds of concerts and shows, you will be able to admire the exact replica of Napoleon 1st 's statue, which used to stay at the top of the Colonne Vendôme in Paris: the Emperor weraring a cocked hat takes pride of place at the top of a pyramidal staircase, which displays the names of his victories and achievements. The gardens shelter huge rocks where Napoleon used to play in his childhood; those rocks are called « Grotte Napoleon » by the people of Ajaccio.

# AJACCIO The Imperial City

Located at the heart of Ajaccio, in the picturesque district of the city of coloured houses, very lively day and night, with its narrow alleys, cafés, restaurants and shops, the Tino Rossi Port enables you to go and discover the Imperial City.



The Bonaparte Family's House, where Napoleon was born on August 15, 1769 and raised until 9, has become a national museum. It also includes spaces dedicated to the Second Empire and temporary exhibitions. It is open daily for visits (closed on Mondays).

# La Chapelle Impériale

Built by Napoleon III on behalf of Cardinal Fesch, the Imperial Chapel, a historical monument, houses the graves of Cardinal Fesch, Napolean's parents Charles and Laetitia Bonaparte, and other family members.

Opening hours: Winter: 9.15 am to 12.15 pm/2.15 pm to 5.15 pm. Closed on Sundays and Mondays. Summer: 10 am to 5.30 pm daily. Closed on Tuesdays.

In summertime, there is something for every taste: Corsican songs, rock and techno music, French and international pop music... on the port and old town's terraces as well as in one of the numerous straw huts open in sumertime on the Route des Sanguinaires or the Porticcio district.

#### The Beaches

There are many beaches in Ajaccio. Saint François Beach, which is the nearest to the Tino Rossi Port (see picture), is within a 3 min walking distance from there. Just keep walking along Boulevard Lantivy until you get to Plage du Trottel (Trottel Beach) and its straw huts. The numerous little beaches along Route des Sanguinaires and Capu di Feno are very popular among the people of Ajaccio. 300 meters from the Port



# Shopping

Cours Napoleon, which is the central avenue of Ajaccio, and Rue Fesch, a pedestrian area (see picture), are the main shopping streets for strolling, shopping and stopping for a drink at at terrace in order to watch life in Ajaccio. The Ajaccio Tourist Information Office and the Ajaccio Chamber of Commerce and Industry organize many summer entertainement activities every Friday around the « Shopping de Nuit » (Night Shopping).


#### Hiking
